

MILES RIGGS OF ROYDON, ESSEX AND HIS DESCENDANTS

THE ANCESTORS OF "EDWARD OF ROXBURY", MASSACHUSETTS

It is extremely likely that Miles and Agnes were born and married in Hawkshead, Lancashire
 However, the entries in the Hawkshead Parish Registers only start in 1568, and those for Roydon in 1567.
 Therefore it is not feasible to determine in which of these two parishes Richard's christening took place.

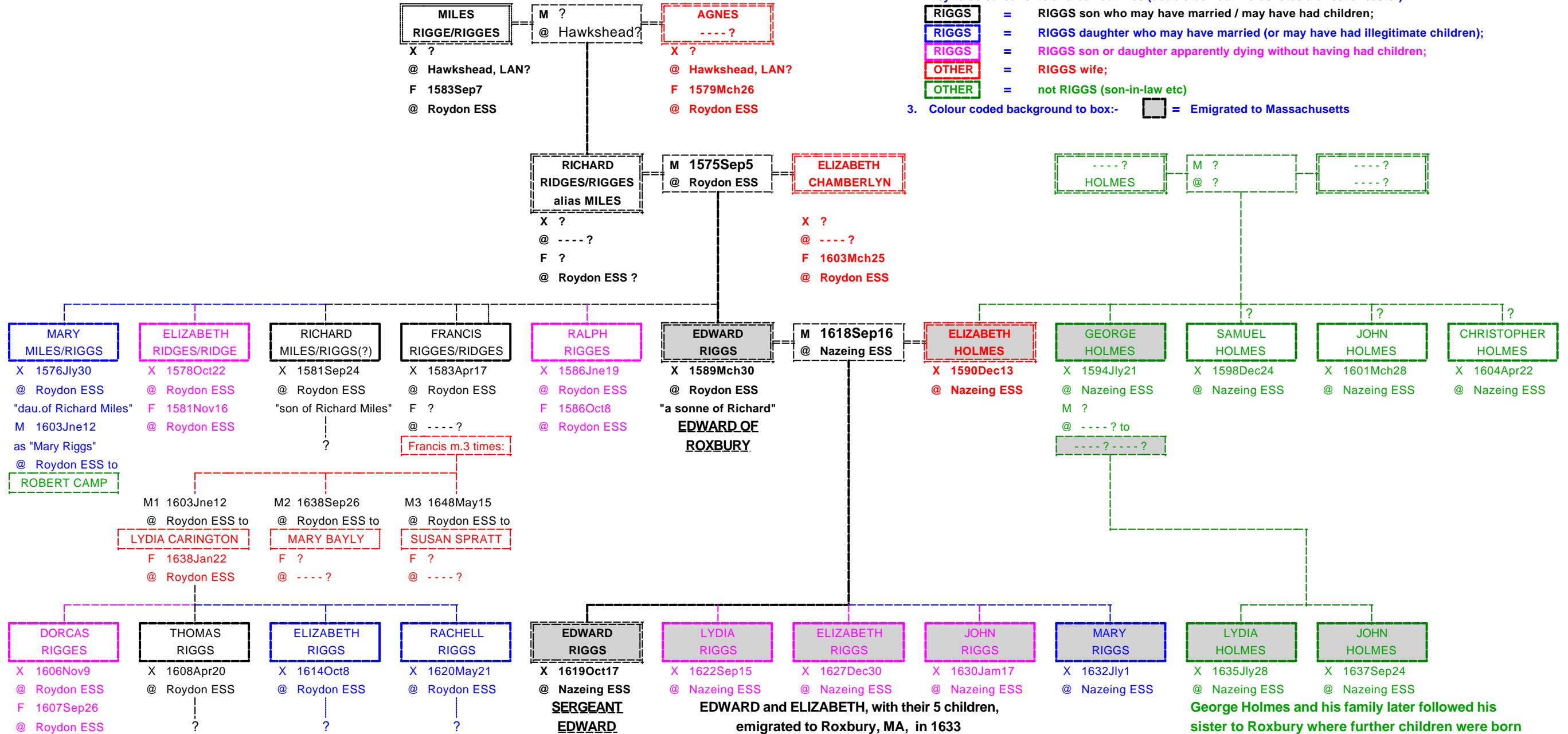
NOTES:

- B = born; X = Christened; M = married (M1 = first marr, etc); D = died; F = funeral/buried;
 c = circa/about; < = before; > = after; ? = unknown, or not proved

- Key to coloured fonts and box outlines (double box outline denotes a direct ancestor):-

- RIGGS = RIGGS son who may have married / may have had children;
- RIGGS = RIGGS daughter who may have married (or may have had illegitimate children);
- RIGGS = RIGGS son or daughter apparently dying without having had children;
- OTHER = RIGGS wife;
- OTHER = not RIGGS (son-in-law etc)

- Colour coded background to box:- = Emigrated to Massachusetts
