NOTE 3 Although no record has been found for a baptism of Grace Jane, a Grace Jane is included in the list for Children's Friend Society Ship 12 with Grace Jane Riggs nee Emery's other children
 Jane Riggs married Joseph Morgenrood as indicated. The Death Notice of Grace Jane Riggs (Note 6) states that death occurred at J.Morgenrood's house in Mount Street, and he was the informant.
 Therefore the Grace Jane in the shipping list and the Jane who married Joseph Morgenrood both refer to a daughter of Grace Jane Riggs nee Emery rather than Grace Jane herself.
 Jane Riggs was a witness to the marriage of Richard Bacchus and Mary Ann Elizabeth Dawley on 1839Dec 2 at St George's Church, Cape Town - source: www.Ancestry24.co.za (subscriber content)

NOTE 8 "ROLFONTIEN" appears after Susan Elizabeth's forenames (with a question mark) in the baptismal record of her son George Edward. However this might refer to her place of origin, because ROLFONTEIN Nature Reserve is south of Vanderkloof, just inside the Northern Province border with the Orange Free State. Her surname appears elsewhere as "NELL" (see Note 9)
